A Personal Message from VBOB President Doug Dillard

Welcome to our VBOB Pilgrimage Tour to Europe commemorating the 70th Anniversary of the Battle of the Bulge.

On our tour, we are proudly following in the footsteps of Generals Eisenhower, Bradley, Patton and Hodges. Commanded by them, we fought hard and were victorious in America's greatest land battle of World War II, the Battle of the Bulge. This led inevitably to German military collapse, victory in Europe, its liberation from Nazism and the founding of NATO. We begin and end our tour in Brussels, HQ of NATO and principal capital of the European Union, as well as being the lively capital city of Belgium. Here we have our Welcome Dinner (I intend to invite the US Ambassador), and our festive Farewell Dinner hosted by the Belgian Army.



Patrick Hinchy is Tour Manager for this special program. Oxford educated, he has spent more than three decades leading military tours in Europe. He has worked with many American Veteran groups gaining a wealth of personal perspectives of WWII combat in Europe. Fluent in English, French and German, he is well known by local officials and his-

tory enthusiasts in Europe and has overseen many memorable events commemorating the return of American Veterans to those communities liberated from the Nazis.





We also stay four nights in Spa, Belgium, HQ of General Courtney Hodges and First Army. This beautiful northern Ardennes town is the original "Spa", made fashionable by the Russian Tsar Peter the Great in the 18th century who specially came here for its refreshing, healing mineral water springs. You can try them too. Our 4-Star hotel is in the elegant central square of Spa.

Then we stay three nights in Luxembourg City, HQ of General Omar Bradley and 12th Army Group, and of General George Patton and Third Army. We stay in the very same 4-Star hotel used by General Eisenhower, General Bradley and General Patton. You can see the his-

toric photo of them in the hotel. Luxembourg City is in the southern Ardennes. It is extraordinarily split by a minicanyon and is one of the most dramatically beautiful capital cities of Europe. For the ladies, it has a pedestrianized center with excellent shopping.




Details of our tour are still being fi-

Tour Itinerary

Monday, December 8, 2014. USA / Aloft: You book your own roundtrip flights from the USA to Brussels International Airport [BRU], Belgium.

Tuesday, December 9. Brussels: We have our own shuttle bus service from Brussels BRU International Airport to our central Brussels hotel meeting all our incoming flights. Free time for sight-seeing and shopping in central Brussels. Patrick will advise and help you. Grand Welcome Dinner. We intend to invite the US Ambassador as our Guest of Honor. (D)

Wednesday, December 10. Brussels / Camp Elsenborn / Malmedy / Spa: We track the formidable German spearhead offensive by Sixth Panzer Army led by Peiper and the 1st SS Leibstandarte 'Adolf Hitler' Division, via Elsenborn and Malmedy. In Camp Elsenborn, the Association of Bulge Museums is planning a special "Introduction to the Battle of the Bulge" exhibition for us, to stimulate the memories of our veterans and educate our younger generations. (B, L)

Thursday, December 11. Spa / La Gleize-Stoumont / Parker's Crossroads / Spa: We continue tracking the German Sixth Panzer Army to its desperately isolated position and inevitable defeat around La Gleize-Stoumont. We celebrate First Army's stubborn defense of the Bulge's northern shoulder with a ceremony and festive lunch at Parker's Crossroads. (B, L)

Friday, December 12. Spa / Henri-Chapelle US Cemetery / M&Ms / Aachen / Spa: A relaxed day. First, our own solemn and moving wreath-laying ceremony with an Honor Guard at Henri-Chapelle American Cemetery. Then to the M&Ms (Marcel and Mathilde) for a fun lunch at their Belgian farm with their amazing private World War II museum. Afterwards, sightseeing and free time in nearby Aachen, the beautiful German cathedral city with its famous Christmas market. (B, L)

Saturday, December 13. Spa / Bastogne / Spa: After Sixth Panzer Army's defeat, the powerful German Fifth Panzer Army under top panzer general and Hitler favorite, General Manteuffel, took up the chase. But, its defeat too, became inevitable after Third Army succeeded in relieving the besieged Bastogne, thus piercing the flank of the Bulge. We devote today to Bastogne, where we have the honor of meeting His Majesty King Philip of the Belgians at a private closed reception. (B, L)

Sunday, December 14. Spa / St. Vith / Clervaux / Luxembourg: Today we track Fifth Panzer Army's powerful initial advance from the German border. Enjoy a special exhibition about St Vith's heroic "Horseshoe Defense," a WWII military vehicles convoy and ceremonies at the Rencheux 82nd Airborne Monument and at the GI Monument in Clervaux. (B, L)

Monday, December 15. Luxembourg / Diekirch / Luxembourg: Another relaxed, fun day. We go to Diekirch High School. The students want to ask our Veterans questions, and invite us to lunch at the school. Then, afternoon free time to visit Diekirch, and its National Museum of Military History (many say the best Battle of the Bulge museum). In the evening we enjoy one of the fabulous Patton Concerts. Hosted by Helen Patton, granddaughter of General George S. Patton. It will include: The Spitfire Sisters, an Andrews Sisters style, three part harmony band with swing classics, and the Thomas Blug Allstars, Rock and Roll music paying homage to the Greatest Generation. (B, L)

Tuesday, December 16. Luxembourg / US Cemetery / Wiltz / Schumanns Eck / Luxembourg: Today we solemnly commemorate the 70th Anniversary of the opening day of the Battle of the Bulge. We take part in two important and prestigious ceremonies. First, a wreath-laying ceremony with US Honor Guard in Luxembourg American Cemetery where General Patton is buried. Then we go to Wiltz (hard fought for on the Bulge's southern flank) for lunch. This is followed by our ceremony with Honor Guard at Luxembourg's National Liberation Monument at Schumann's Eck. You also have free time in Luxembourg City. Tonight our Grand Finale Dinner in Luxembourg. (B, L, D)

Wednesday, December 17. Luxembourg / Brussels: This morning we return to Brussels. We go close to the farthest point of the German Bulge advance near the River Meuse. We have a panoramic sightseeing tour of Brussels and free time in its center. Enjoy the Christmas market in Brussels magnificent 17th century "Grand Place". We spend our final evening having a great celebratory Farewell Dinner with the Belgian Army. (B, D)

Thursday, December 18. Brussels / USA: Our VBOB Pilgrimage Tour to Europe commemorating the 70th Anniversary of the Battle of the Bulge is finally over. But we return home with unique and unforgettable memories, and the firm resolution that this great American military achievement which was the Battle of the Bulge must be remembered and commemorated in perpetuity.
