Dominick fought under Generals Omar Bradley and George S. Patton, and received an honorable discharge; and

Dominick worked throughout Connecticut and New York and in commercial construction for more than 50 years; and

WHEREAS:

Dominick married and had two children, seven grandchildren and three great-grandchildren; and

On May 8, 2012 at West Point Military Academy, the Ambassador of France awarded Dominick with the Chevalier of the Legion of Honor, with deep appreciation and gratitude from President Nicholas Sarkozy and the people of France.
