## A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE 285TH ENGINEER COMBAT BATTALION

December 17, 1943	Activated this date at Camp Crowder, Missouri under Table of Organization 5-15 (15 Jul 43) with 29 officers, 3 warrant officers and 632 enlisted men.
Into 1944	Received full complement of personnel, organized units and trained at Camp Crowder, Camp Campbell, Kentucky and Camp Shelby, Mississippi.
October 22, 1944	Sailed from NYPOE aboard the SS Marine Raven and landed at Barry, Wales on 2 Nov 44. Moved by rail to Delamere Park Camp, 1 mile NW of Cuddington Station, England. Continued unit training.
January 7, 1945	The "Battle of the Bulge" terminated training and unit embarked from Southampton, landing at Le Havre, France on 9 Jan 45. Existed at Camp Twenty Grand, near Duclair, France on salmon, cheese and bread and marmalade for over a week. Moved by "40 & 8's" from Twenty Grand arriving at Ukange, France on 20 Jan 45 then on by truck to Dalheim, Luxembourg.
January 22, 1945 to March 1, 1945	The first mission of the 285th was as an infantry holding force along the Moselle River - part of Task Force Reed, whose mission was to screen the right flank of XII Corps, Third U.S. Army under Gen. Patton.
March 1, 1945	Relieved from Task Force Reed and assigned to 1137th Engr. C Gp.
March 13, 1945	Crossed Sauer River from Luxembourg into Germany!
March 16, 1945	Put in Direct Support of the 11th Armored Division.
March 24, 1945	Put in Direct Support of the 4th Armored Division.
March 25/27, 1945	Crossed the RHINE at Oppenheim with XII Corps.
March 31, 1945	General Support of the 4th Armored under 1135th Engr. C Gp.
April 7, 1945	Put in Direct Support of the 71st Infantry Division.
April 19, 1945 to May 22, 1945	Put in Direct Support of the 26th Infantry Division.
Notes: 1.	The war in the ETO ended at Midnight, 8 May 45 with the 285th then located in Mistlberg, Austria.
2.	From 3 Nov 44 to 8 May 45 the Rettellon CP was located at 22 various

- 2. From 3 Nov 44 to 8 May 45 the Battalion CP was located at <u>32</u> various sites in England, France, Luxembourg, Germany & Austrial
- 3. The 285th participated in three campaigns in the ETO: Ardennes-Alsace, Rhineland and Central Europe.
- 4. Inactivated 19 Nov 45 at Camp Patrick Henry, Oriana, Virginia. This is now the site of the Newport News/Williamsburg International Airport.
- 5. The Command Posts and routes of each element of the Battalion varied considerably during the campaigns in Europe.
